## The ACDP:

- Protects religious rights and ensured that South Africa today is not a secular state and that religious observances may be conducted in state institutions.
- Supports an open-market economy with a social conscience.
- Protects property rights and opposes the expropriation of land without compensation.

- Opposed government's draconian Covid-19 lockdown regulations that devastated livelihoods and our economy.
  We also opposed mandatory vaccines for Covid-19 and legally defended many who were unjustly fired for refusing to be vaccinated against their will.
- Provides vital oversight. Our key role in Parliament's Eskom Enquiry into state capture and corruption is one such example.
- Protects family values and opposes abortion-on-demand, pornography, and attempts to legalise prostitution. We also opposed government's Comprehensive Sexuality Education (CSE) curriculum.
- Promotes quality education where parents play a central role, and protects the rights of home schoolers. We opposed the Basic Education Laws Amendment Bill (BELA Bill) where thousands of submissions opposing the bill were ignored.
- Opposes the General Intelligence Laws Amendment Bill which will require state security vetting for anyone wanting to establish a non-governmental organisation or church.
